However, the concept of Sustainable cities and sustainable housing requires a new understanding to effectively and synergistically address the pressing issues slums, increasing population, the urban divide, economic and human development, and climate change.

By 2030, according to the projections of the United Nations (UN) Population Division, each of the major regions of the developing world is estimated to hold more urban than rural dwellers; by 2050 fully two-thirds of their inhabitants are likely to live in urban areas. By 2050, India is likely to be the most populous country with a projected population of 1.69 billion. It is estimated that over 70 million new urban housing units will be needed over the next 20 years in India.

Hence in order to balance environment with urban growth, we shall have to draw on multiple branches of knowledge and concepts including Sustainable communities, sustainable cities, inclusive cities, liveable cities, green cities, prosperous cities, eco-cities, healthy cities and resilient cities.

Sustainable Housing for Sustainable Cities outlines key concepts and considerations underpinning the idea of sustainable housing and provides a comprehensive framework for designing sustainable housing policies and practical actions.

Aims:




Figure-1: Proposed Methodology






